However, National Club Sport selection is part of the criteria for our Sporting Encouragement Award.

Junior and Senior Sportsperson of the Year Point Selection Criteria:

- 15 – Australian State School Sport Representative
- 10 – Queensland State School Sport Representative
- 5 – Capricornia School Sport Representative
- 3 – Rockhampton and District School Sport Representative
- 3 – Glenmore State High School Carnival Age Champion

Sporting Encouragement Award – Awarded to the student from any year level who has demonstrated sporting prowess with their potential to represent their chosen sport at a National Level.
