ENROLMENT AGREEMENT

This enrolment agreement sets out the responsibilities of the student, parents or carers and the school staff about the education of students enrolled at Glenmore State High School.

Responsibility of student to:

- exercise common-sense in all situations
- behave and speak courteously to all members of the school community
- co-operate with teachers and other members of the school community
- show concern and respect for other people, their property and the school environment
- try hard to succeed to the best of my ability
- attend school daily, be well prepared for and on time for all classes
- respect other students' rights to learn and be taught
- comply with the school uniform code
- participate in and actively support school activities
- act safely and sensibly within the school grounds and buildings
- maintain a safe and hygienic school environment
- behave in a way that upholds the law

Responsibility of parents to:

- · provide a home environment which supports home study and learning
- ensure that all necessary materials for learning are available
- ensure that students are well groomed and wear the full school uniform at all times
- ensure regular attendance and provide written confirmation of any absences that occur
- encourage the involvement of my student in the total life of the school, so that she/he fulfil her/his potential
- be aware of school enrolment and other policies
- accept responsibility for the payment of school resource fees and fees associated with the loss
 or damage of school property (within reasonable expectations); and
- seek assistance from the school if my student finds difficulty in fulfilling obligations and expectations
- attend open evenings for parents
- treat school staff with respect and tolerance
- support the authority and discipline of the school enabling my child to achieve maturity, selfdiscipline and self-control
- abide by school's policy regarding access to school grounds before, during and after school hours

Responsibility of school to:

- develop each individual student's talent as fully as possible
- inform parents and carers regularly about how their children are progressing





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- inform students, parents and carers about the course intent that the teachers will cover
- teach effectively and to set the highest standards in work and behaviour
- take reasonable steps to ensure the safety, happiness and self-confidence of all students
- be open and welcoming at all reasonable times and offer opportunities for parents and carers to become involved in the school community
- clearly articulate the school's expectations regarding the Responsible Behaviour Plan for students and the school's dress code
- ensure that parents are aware of the school's record-keeping policy including the creation of a transfer note should the student enrol at another school
- set, mark and monitor homework regularly in keeping with the school's homework policy
- contact parents and carers as soon as practical if the school is concerned about the child's school work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality
- deal with complaints in an open, fair and transparent manner
- consult parents on any major issues affecting students
- treat students and parents with respect and tolerance
