







Auto Ready - Introduction to Automotive

This course is designed to provide students with a basic introduction to the automotive industry.

Course overview

Students undertaking this course will learn a range of tasks relating to using and maintaining tools and equipment and identifying and inspecting mechanical and electrical components and systems of light vehicles.

Accredited units

To successfully complete this course. you must be assessed as competent in the following units:

- AURTTK102 Use and maintain tools and equipment in an automotive workplace
- AURETR103 Identify automotive electrical systems and components
- AURLTA101 Identify automotive mechanical systems and components

Course length

Five days of face-to-face college-based training and assessment.

Fee information

This course is subsidised through the Queensland Government under the Certificate 3 Guarantee program. Training is provided fee-free for VET in School students. To be eligible candidates must:

- be a Queensland resident:
- be aged 15 years or over and a school student in Year 10, 11 or 12;
- be an Australian citizen, Australian Permanent resident, temporary resident with necessary visa permits on a pathway to permanent residency; or a New Zealand citizen; and

• not hold or be enrolled in a Certificate III level or higher qualification (not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training).

Dates are scheduled regularly throughout the year - during the school holiday period.
