This funding will be used to

- **Improvement Priority 1: Improving the teaching and learning of mathematics**
 - Increase Year 7 - 10 Mathematics at least 80% of students to attain a C or higher with no individual class less than 70%.
 - Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN numeracy MSS to improve by at least 45 points.
- **Improvement Priority 2: Reading**
 - Focus on Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN (reading) MSS results improve by at least 40 points.
- **Improvement in curriculum delivery and alignment**
- **Improvement in pedagogy approaches**

Our initiatives include

- Participation in a Community of Practice (Mathematics).
- All teachers to be proficient in Explicit Instruction and Group Work.
- All Mathematics teachers to develop proficiency in Reading to Learn Strategies.
- Embed Reading to Learn in SOSE, Mathematics and Science.
- Increase the number of Teacher Aides to assist students in Reading and Mathematics.
- Increase wellbeing support of students in improvement areas through the use of the Chaplain.
- Increase engagement in LoTE reading through technology.
- Increase Mathematics participation through STEM and Maker Space.
- English initiatives to support reading focus including John Collins, Rebecca De Smith and Spelling Mastery.
