Glenmore State High School offers many methods of payment

BPoint – Register with QParents by obtaining an email invitation from the school office. Follow the emailed instructions to establish your QParents account. To make a payment, select the PAYMENTS Tab, select the invoice you wish to pay, and follow the prompts to complete your payment.

Direct Credit via Internet Banking –

Payment Window – Visit the school administration (Student Services) window to pay by EFTPOS (no cash out), cheque or cash. Open Monday to Friday from 8.00am – 3.30pm.

Centrepay Automatic Deductions – Centrepay is a free voluntary service offered by the Commonwealth Government to Centrelink payment recipients. Eligible parents can use Centrepay to pay educational fees, as regular deductions from their Centrelink payments.

Fortnightly deductions can be made from Family Tax Benefit, Pension or Newstart payments. Fortnightly/monthly payments can be set up via your MyGov account online, or by visiting any Centrelink office in person. A Centrepay form will be provided with this letter for completion if this method is preferred.
