## Student Dress Code 2022

Our Student Dress Code applies to all students of Glenmore State High School. This code has been approved by the P&C and takes into account workplace health and safety obligations for the safety of both our students and staff. Our school colours are black, burnt orange and white and our uniforms come with a variety of identifying embroidery. On enrolment, every student and parent will sign a commitment to adhere to this student dress code. Students are expected to be clean, well groomed and at all times present a positive and proud image of Glenmore State High School. Students who do not comply with the Student Dress Code may be asked to change or may be sent home to change into their school uniform and be required to make up any classes missed.

### Workplace Health and Safety Considerations

Wearing of loose clothing in some situations is a hazard - shirts are to be tucked in for some subjects.

Open footwear such as sandals and thongs are NOT permitted at any time, this includes when seniors are on exam block.

### Individual Considerations

There are circumstances where a student may require an exemption from the Student Dress Code. Requested exemptions must be approved by SWEL and noted in the school computer system.

### P & C Uniform Shop

The Uniform Shop is open each Monday during school term from 8:30am-12.00pm. We are open other days throughout the year advised in newsletters or school Facebook page. Outside of these hours, enquiries can be made at the school office.

### Uniform Compliance

This Student Dress Code applies to **ALL** students.

The school determines an appropriate course of action for uniform breaches and students are reminded of compliance conditions regularly.

The only logo allowed to be worn in school grounds is the school logo.

Representative Sports Uniforms **AND** Specialty Wear are **NOT** to be worn as general school uniform.

Students wearing a plain black substitute **MUST NOT** have a logo.

### Uniform Purchases

All uniform items are available through the uniform shop on a Monday morning. Payment can be made over the phone during this time if needed.

We accept cash, eftpos (not Amex sorry), and layby payments for uniform purchases.

Layby payments need to be opened and finalised in the same school term. It is a requirement that the student makes a payment every week for layby items. Uniforms are given to the student on payment of the final layby payment.

## Shirts

- Everyday Polo Shirt: White, black and orange worn with sports shorts
- Formal Shirt: White with orange and black pinstripes, black and orange tie worn with formal shorts, skirt, trousers or slacks
- Senior Shirt: Year 12 students have a senior shirt designed each year that can be worn in place of the sports polo shirt.

## Shoes/Socks

Shoes must protect your feet. Slip on shoes are not permitted.

- Black leather shoes or black joggers
- Plain black or plain white socks above the ankle
- Black shoes **MUST** be worn with the school formal uniform
- School socks are available and encouraged to be worn when representing the school.

## Accessories

Accessories worn by a student **MUST** comply with safety considerations. Everyone is expected to present themselves in a well-groomed appearance.

### Allowed jewellery includes:

- Wrist watch
- One flat ring, **NO** raised surfaces
- Stud earring / sleeper (**ONLY** in ear lobes)
- Studs should not be larger than 3mm in diameter and sleepers no larger than 12mm in diameter
- Nose piercing must be clear and flat
- Piercings **MAY** need to be covered for workplace health and safety reasons
- Sleepers are **NOT** allowed to be worn in the septum
- Fake nails **ARE NOT** allowed.

**Note: Accessory items NOT listed above MUST be removed. Requested exemptions to the items above must be approved by SWEL and noted in the school computer system.**

## Hairstyle

Hair **MUST** be neat and clean.

**Note: Sculptured mohawk cuts are NOT acceptable.**

## Shorts/Skirts/Trousers/Slacks

- Black GSHS Uniform
- Length must be halfway down individual student thigh
- Tights/leggings can be worn under school shorts
- Football shorts are **NOT** acceptable.

**Note: Black denim / skinny jeans are NOT acceptable.**

## Hat / Cap and Sun Safety

Students are expected to take responsibility for sun protection by wearing hat/caps when outside. Hat/caps must be worn correctly with brim over face during outdoor activities and as part of any classes. Hats/caps **MUST** be removed when entering a classroom and are **NOT** to be worn indoors. The following items are acceptable:

- GSHS bucket hat or school cap
- Plain black wide brim hat or cap.

**Note: Bandanas are NOT to be worn.**

## Winter Uniform

- GSHS winter uniform preferred on cold days, school polo shirt must be worn
- Mostly plain black substitute acceptable, **NO** logos
- Hoodies / beanies **NOT** to be worn indoors
- Leggings/tights may be worn under shorts.

**Note: Other coloured jackets, checked jackets and flannelette shirts are unacceptable.**

## Formal Uniform

Students are able to wear the formal uniform for every day wear provided it is worn in full. This includes:

- Formal blouse/shirt
- Formal skirt/shorts/slacks/trousers
- Formal tie and school socks
- Black shoes.

Students may be requested to wear their formal uniform when representing the school, for awards ceremonies and other events as advised by their teacher.

## Specialty Class Wear

Individual specialty class clothing requirements should be obtained from the relevant Faculty. Clothing and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is to be changed into before your class and back into your school uniform at end of class.

## Sports Houses

Gunyanni (tree) – yellow

Lucrapana (canoe) – red

Errabunga (fish) – green

Narrawa (spring water) – blue

**Note: Polo Shirts in House colours may be worn for school sport events only. Sports themed dressing up is announced on student notices and the school Facebook page.**

## Special Non-Uniform Dress Days

Special free dress days are announced on student notices and the school Facebook page. Students **MUST** wear appropriate clothing to ensure Sun Safety. Students are **NOT** allowed to wear singlets or strapless tops. Students who do not participate in free dress are expected to be in full school uniform.

## Students Representing the School

### Academic

Students representing the school in academic events **MAY** be required to wear the formal uniform. When representing the School, the formal uniform **MUST** be worn in full.

### Excursions

Full School Uniform **MUST** be worn on all excursions unless otherwise advised.

### Representative Sports/Teams

Individual sports/teams clothing requirements should be obtained from the relevant Faculty.

Clothing is to be changed into before your relevant class or activity and back into your school uniform at end of class or activity.

We encourage all representative sports/teams participants to wear our school team sports uniform and if you are not able to, then you are required to wear your normal school uniform, not the formal uniform.

Dragons Football Shorts: may be required for team sport participants.

Dragons Football Socks: to be worn as part of the school sport uniform for all sporting teams.
