<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the month of April – Loss of \$10 367.47 for the month <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NB: Only 9 days of tuckshop sales in April • Same time last year was \$21 494 Loss • P&C Qld Mship was paid this month of \$3260.56 (slight increase from last year) • 2nd Pmt of \$2025 paid for Home Ec kitchen screens also • Tuckshop sales up by \$3 127 compared to same time last year • Tuckshop expenses up by \$ 3 041 compared to last year • Uniform shop sales up by \$520 from last year • Tuckshop P&L for the month of April – Loss of \$ 7 262.40
